When processing personal data, we will uphold the following standards:

Ensure we are operating...

Fairly, lawfully and in a transparent manner and only collect data for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes. We will not process it in ways that are not compatible with what we have told you.

• Employ data minimisation...

To limit the collection of personal information to that which is directly relevant and necessary to accomplish a specified purpose.

• Observe data subject rights...

To ensure that the rights that are afforded to individuals under the UKGDPR are upheld appropriately and in accordance with the regulation and associated legislation.

• Be accountable...

By all staff adhering to and remaining compliant with all of the UKGDPR principles and contributing to demonstrating the organisations compliance.

• Use anonymisation, pseudonymisation and encryption...

Where possible and appropriate staff to anonymise/pseudonymise and encrypt personal data in order to protect the privacy rights of individuals.

• Use the model of least privilege...

In order to ensure that personal data is only accessed by staff that have a defined need to access it, we will ensure that security controls are implemented to data held physically and electronically, and we will review the access controls and permissions on a regular basis
